## Staff Planning Guide

1994 Tour Routing Reference and 2026 Tour Schedule

### Purpose

This guide provides staff with the working 2026 Liberty Bell Tour schedule, the geographic routing reference drawn from the 1994 statewide tour, regional support assignments, route maps, and estimated daily mileage. The 1994 Tour is used as a routing reference only; all 2026 fixed events and operational requirements take precedence.

## General Guidelines

- **Use the 1994 Tour as the routing reference.** The 1994 statewide route is the template for efficient town-to-town travel and minimizing backtracking.
- **Protect fixed 2026 commitments.** Scheduled events take priority. Travel before and after fixed events should support timely arrival and setup.
- **Sundays are off.** No public tour activity or long-distance travel should be scheduled on Sundays unless the plan is formally revised.
- **Travel by geography; coordinate by region.** A250 region numbers identify the regional team responsible for local coordination. Regional boundaries should not force inefficient routing.
- **Keep mileage reasonable.** Daily mileage figures are planning estimates. Routes should be adjusted when needed to avoid overly heavy travel days while maintaining forward geographic movement.
- **Avoid backtracking.** Whenever possible, the bell should overnight near the end of the day's route and resume from that area on the next travel day.
- **Use route maps as planning tools.** The blue-line map shows the intended sequence of travel. Final roads, stop addresses, timing, and mileage should be confirmed before each leg is finalized.
- **November is limited to already scheduled commitments.** No additional statewide touring should be added in November without a specific schedule revision.

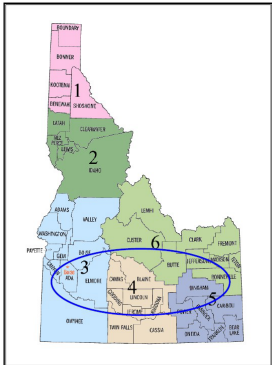
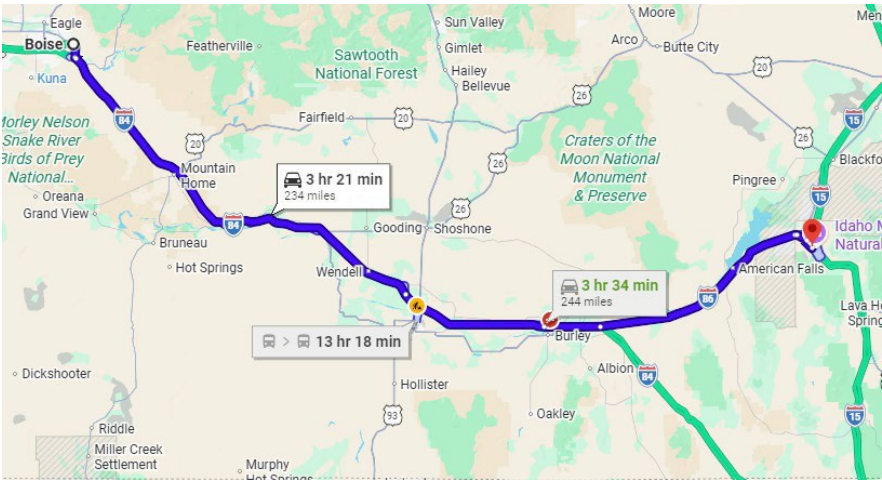
- Only travel on the approved daily route.
- Bell to be always supervised/secured.
- Notify local law enforcement prior to arrival at each stop and keep record of the name and phone number of law enforcement officer contacted.

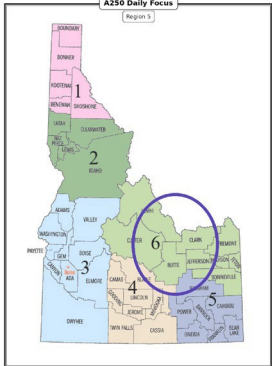
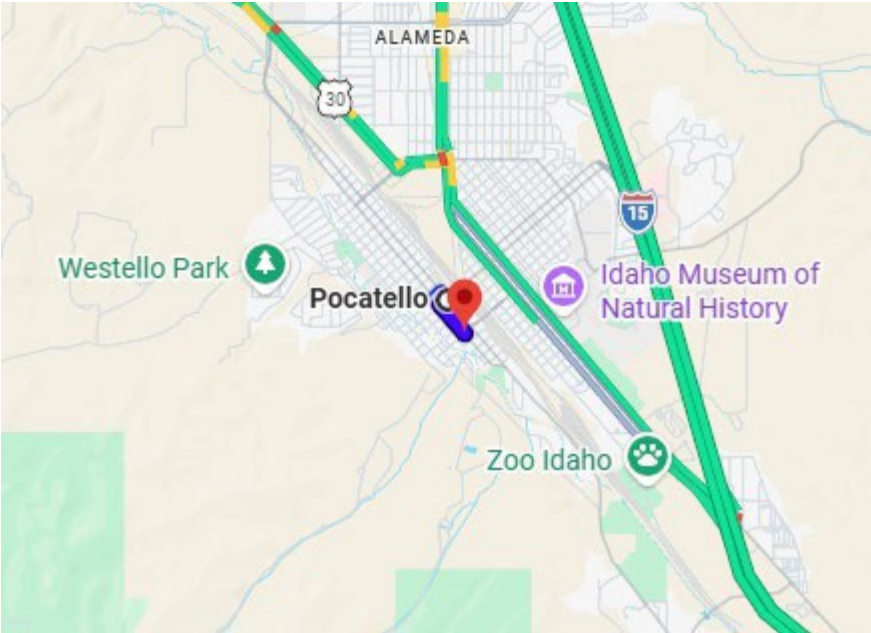
